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The **New-Auburn Hills Enrichment Program** for home school and charter school students is a collaboration between Newcastle, Auburn Union, and Placer Hills School Districts. Students from all three districts may participate. 2011-2012 school year classes will be held at Alta Vista Education Center and Newcastle Elementary School.

Enrichment classes are hands-on, relevant, and inquiry-based activities delivered in a student-centered, nurturing environment.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

PE Activities: Students participate in a variety of physical education activities integrated through K-8 grade levels. Activities are both inside and outside depending on the weather. For safety reasons please have your student wear tennis shoes (no flip flops or sandals). Classes are held on Mondays from 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. at Alta Vista Education Center. (Teacher: Laurie Farley)

Other PE- classes include:

Classroom PE: Class days, times, and teachers will vary depending on grade level. These classes are held at Newcastle School.

Karate: Students in grades K-4 learn karate on Mondays from 7:45 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. at Newcastle School. (Teacher: Woodall Academy)

Soccer: Classes for students in grades K-6 are held Mondays from 7:45 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. at Newcastle School. (Teacher: A.R.T. Soccer—Charles Serano)

MATH

Logic Problems, Math Games, and Puzzles: This class is designed for students in grades 3-8. This 7-week class is held Fridays from 10:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. at the Alta Vista Education Center. (Teacher: Jen Russell)

Advanced Math (Grades 3-8) & Math Tutoring for All Grades: This class is designed for those students learning Algebra or Geometry and other higher level math, and serves as a math tutoring resource for all grade. Classes are held on Thursdays from 1:00 p.m. to 2:30 p.m. at the Alta Vista Education Center. (Teacher: Lisa Voss)

Pre Algebra and Algebra: Students in grades 6-8 attend class on Mondays and Thursdays from 2:45 p.m. to 3:45 p.m. at Newcastle School. (Teacher: Mr. Sarkisian)

COMPUTERS

Computer Time: A variety of computer-based learning programs are available for students in grades 3-8 including Rosetta Stone to learn any language of your choice, Accelerated Reading and Math, Type to Learn, Power Point and other digital learning activities. Classes are held Wednesdays from 2:30 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. at the Alta Vista Education Center computer lab (located on the Huntley St. side) (Teacher: John Green)

ART

Leonardo da Vinci and the Art of Flight: Learn about the history of flight (1500 AD - present time) over five weeks. Students in grades 5-8 construct model aircraft for hands-on experiments. This class integrates math, science, art, history, and language arts lessons through a variety of activities. Classes are held Mondays from 12:30 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. at Alta Vista Education Center for a 5 week period. (Teacher: Jim Bennett)

Art: This class for students in grades K-8 is offered on Mondays from 7:45 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. at Newcastle School (Teacher: Tracy Owens)

MUSIC

Band: This class provides students in grades 4-8 the opportunity to participate in band. Students audition in order to be placed in the appropriate level of band. Classes are held Mondays and Thursdays from 7:30 a.m. to 8:15 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. to 9:15 a.m. (depending on the level of band) at Newcastle School. (Teacher: Diane Noya)

Other music-based classes include:

Musical Theater: Classes for student in in grades 5-8 are held Mondays from 7:45 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. at Newcastle School. (Teacher: McLaughlin Studios)

Classroom Music: Student in in grades K-5 can participate in classroom art lessons. Class days (either Monday or Thursday) and times will vary depending on grade level. These classes are held at Newcastle School. (Teacher: Holly Dees)

Guitar: This class for students in grades K-8 is offered on Mondays from 7:45 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. at Newcastle School (Teacher: Mr. Baker)

Choir: This class for students in grades 6-8 is offered on Mondays and Thursday from 11:45 a.m. to 12:20 p.m. at Newcastle School (Teacher: Holly Dees)
